The Samvid Scholarship empowers future leaders by providing up to \$50K for two years of study in an eligible graduate program, leadership development programming, and a robust alumni network.

- Applicants must be pursuing a full-time graduate program of 2 years or longer at a U.S. university in one of the following programs: MD, MBA, JD, MPP/MPA, MPH, EdD, MS/MA in the social sciences or STEM; have an undergraduate GPA of at least 3.5; and be a U.S. citizen of DACA recipient
